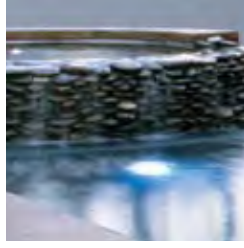

Stucco walls, a low-hipped clay tile roof, Brazilian cherry wood intermingled with marble floors, and unobtrusive maple built-ins discern a naturally graceful volume. The clerestory guides ample light throughout the rooms. Instead, its sweeping bell-shaped façade gently slopes down and out, mimicking the raised curved element in the gables, to suggest a whimsical—but not overdone—attitude; it perfectly expresses the happy homeowners. Inside, a linear design meets the eye with tight, right angles throughout, ensuring not one foot of space is wasted.
